Service Hours Information

Rising 5th-8th graders at SLS and candidates for Confirmation may begin performing his/her 2021/2022 service hours on May 29, 2021. A list of pre-approved service suggestions (both community and parish) follows. A student may choose to conduct all service hours in the parish. If you wish to perform a service not on this list please check with Mr. Walker before performing the service. Mr. Walker will approve all hours for all grades (5th-8th grades) during summer 2021. Once the school year begins, SLS 5th - 8th graders will get their hours approved in person by their Religion teacher. **ALL SERVICE HOURS NOT ALREADY ON THE PRE-APPROVED LIST MUST BE APPROVED. ANY HOURS NOT PRE-APPROVED WILL NOT BE COUNTED.**

Additionally, a St. Louis service hour form must be completed. Your teacher will provide you with the appropriate form. This form requires a signature from someone at the agency or organization where you provided service to confirm your hours. Parent signatures are never accepted.

Signatures should be obtained as the hours are performed. **If this is not possible, students will have one month after the service was performed to obtain the appropriate signature.**

The service hour form will be turned in to your Religion/Confirmation class teacher. Due dates are listed on the back of the service hours form.

2021-2022 Requirements

St. Louis School 5th Grade: 5 total hours (2 of which must be parish hours)
St. Louis School 6th Grade: 10 total hours (3 of which must be parish hours)
St. Louis School 7th Grade: 15 total hours (5 of which must be parish hours)
St. Louis School 8th Grade: 20 total hours (7 of which must be parish hours)
St. Agnes-St. Dominic Confirmandi: 5 parish hours
St. Louis Church PRE Confirmandi: 20 total hours (7 of which must be parish hours)



Determining Your Service

In determining your community service, try to find opportunities that directly serve the poor or those in true need of service. Service hours are unpaid hours. Pre-approved opportunities are listed below.

These are certainly not the only hours you can perform. If you have other ideas for service hours, contact your Religion/Confirmation teacher. **All hours MUST be pre-approved.**

Students do not receive service hours for working fundraisers that benefit them. For example, working a fundraiser is not service if you are raising money for a mission trip.



Babysitting and yardwork are typically not approved for service hours. Contact your teacher for specific situations where this might count.

Students should also not combine Religion/Confirmation service hours with service hours for other organizations (i.e. Beta Club, National Junior Honor Society, scouts, cheerleading, SAA-SDS requirements, etc.).

Youth cannot earn service hours during the school day.
